Authentic Materials and Children's resources

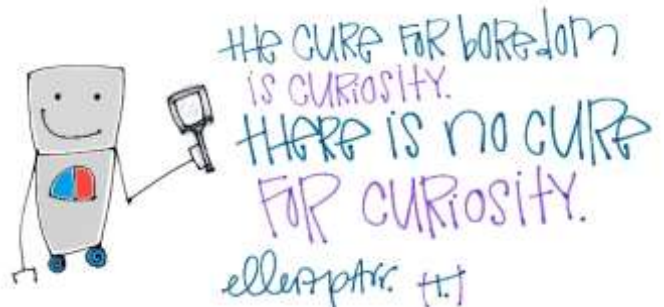


As we continue to embed the Curiosity Approach, we have replaced more of our plastic toys with some beautiful authentic recycled materials.
