Weather

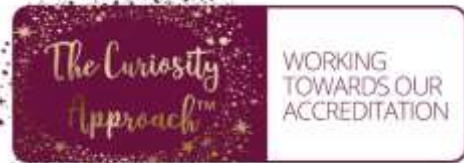
Please can we remind you that your child needs to be suitably dressed for all weathers.

The Curiosity Approach is an inspirational modern day approach to early childhood which takes inspiration from across the world using elements from the Reggio approach (Italy), Steiner approach (Austria), the Te Whariki early childhood education curriculum of New Zealand and a sprinkle of Montessori underpinned by the Early Years Foundation Stage (UK).

It is a beautiful recipe of wonderful ingredients carefully mixed together with experience, passion and a love of early childhood bringing curiosity, awe and wonder back into early years creating 'thinkers and doers' of the future.
